Cleary University – Tuition Benefits Program FAQs

Q: Who can participate?

A: All eligible Team Schostak employees, immediate family members and grandchildren.

Q: What is my out of pocket expense per semester?

A: Online courses are free. Each student is required to pay a technology fee of \$425.00 per semester which includes ALL digital books and course materials through Redshelf.

Q: What type of degrees does Cleary offer?

A: Cleary University has over 20 different Business degrees as well Hospitality and Culinary programs. www.cleary.edu/programs/

Q: Do I need to apply for financial aid?

A: Yes, everyone in the Team Schostak Benefit Program will need to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to being registered for classes.

Go to: <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>. All federal grants (free money) will be applied toward tuition.

Q: Are there time requirements to finish a degree?

A: Yes, 6 years for a bachelor's degree and 3 years for a master's degree.

Q: What happens if I am no longer employed by Team Schostak?

A: You and your family members can continue your education at Cleary; however, you will revert to the standard university tuition rates. Each semester all participants will be approved by Team Schostak to confirm they are in good standing with the company.

Q: What type of computer do I need to take courses online at Cleary?

A: Students can use an iPad, Chromebook, PC, or Mac.

Q: Can I get my bachelor's degree and then continue on to get my master's degree at Cleary?

A: Only one degree per person is permitted for the Tuition Benefits Program.

Q: What if I need to take a semester off?

A: Students may take a semester off. However, two continuous semesters of not attending Cleary University would require Team Schostak's written approval for the employee to continue and would also qualify as a new seat in the program.

Q: How long is each class?

A: Each semester is 16 weeks, divided into two sessions (A and B). Each session is eight (8) weeks in duration. This allows students six (6) times throughout the year to enroll (Fall A or B, Spring A or B, Summer A or B).
