The North Residence Hall offers fully furnished, semi-private suites with a bedroom, bath, and shared common area with a full kitchen and living/dining area. Details include...

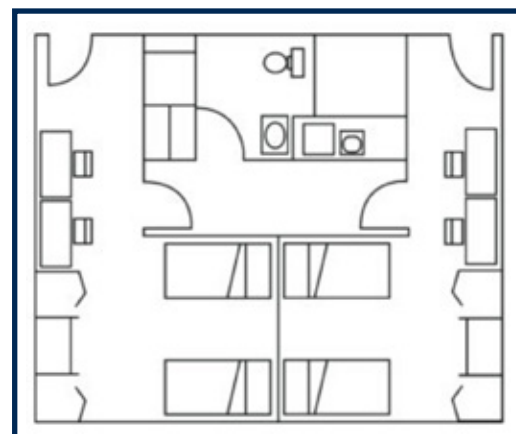
- 2-3 bedrooms, 2-3 bathrooms

## **SOUTH RESIDENCE HALL** (accommodates approx. 110 students)

The South Residence Hall features fully furnished, semi-private, two-bedroom, one-bathroom suites. Details include...

- 2-bedroom, 1-bath
- Same-floor laundry
- Kitchenette, including mini-fridge, microwave & sink
- Study & lounge areas on each floor
- Furnished living environment
- Ethernet ports in every bedroom & campus Wi-Fi

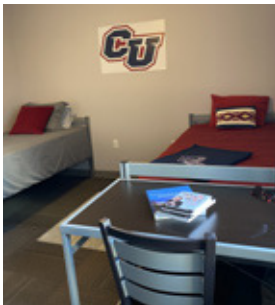
## SAFETY AND STUDENT LIFE

Cleary University Housing provides a safe and supportive environment for students. Full-time professional staff and student resident assistants live in each building. Cleary has a vibrant student life, which includes athletics, clubs, and special events. Campus security is a high priority, and residence halls have ample, well-lit, secure parking.



## APPLICATION, POLICIES, AND PRICING

All undergraduate students are required to live on campus\*. Students must annually submit a Housing Application and pay the \$100 non-refundable application fee. No application will be processed without payment. Housing waivers are required for any student who has cause for an exception. Waivers must be approved by the Director of Housing. Waiver requests for current students are due by **May 1, 2023**.



### **\*Exceptions:**

1. Resides with parents or legal guardians at their primary residence within a 25-mile radius of Cleary University.
2. Has achieved 60+ credit hours toward their undergraduate degree.
3. Is 23 years of age or older by the first day of fall classes.
4. Is legally married.
5. Is a parent of dependent child(ren).
6. Has served as a member of the U.S. Armed Forces.



All students residing in University Housing must retain their residence for the entire academic year unless they withdraw from the University. Rooms are assigned on a first come, first served basis.

*Any new student that has not submitted a housing application or waiver form by May 1, 2022 or five days after acceptance to the University (whichever is later), will be automatically charged room + board plus \$100 application fee and \$100 late fee.*
