

Submit your FAFSA today to see if you qualify!

Paying for college can be stressful. Between scholarships, grants and financial aid, the options can be overwhelming. Cleary University is here to help and is dedicated to working one-on-one with every student to find scholarships, grants and other funding sources to make their degree affordable.

How do you know if you qualify for federal forms of aid?

The Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA) uses a number called the Student Aid Index (SAI), which is based on the financial information you provide. Cleary University uses your SAI to determine financial aid and award packages that include eligibility and award level for the Cougar Country Promise (CCP).

Cougar Country Promise Award Levels

Students are automatically considered for the CCP when they submit a completed FAFSA, qualify for Michigan Achievement Scholarship (MAS) and have an SAI below 30000. The CCP is awarded at four varying levels:

- 1. Students who qualify for the MAS with a negative or zero SAI will be eligible for free tuition.
- 2. Students who qualify for the MAS with a Pell-eligible SAI will pay a maximum out-of-pocket of \$5,000/year for tuition.
- 3. Students who qualify for the MAS that are not Pell-eligible, with an SAI up to 25000 will pay a maximum out-of-pocket of \$7,500/year for tuition.
- 4. Students who qualify for the MAS that have an SAI of 25001-30000 will pay a maximum out-of-pocket of \$10,000/year for tuition.

The CCP does not include the cost of room, board and other applicable fees. Students may also apply a federal student direct loan toward these costs.

COMPLETE THE FAFSA APPLICATION

How to qualify for the Cougar Country Promise Award

- 1. Michigan high school students graduating in Spring 2026 and entering college in Fall 2026 as a first-time, full-time student, qualify for the CCP.
- 2. Complete the FAFSA at studentaid.gov before May 1, 2026, and list Cleary University to receive your financial aid information. Cleary code: 002246.
- 3. When you are admitted to Cleary University and qualify for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, you will automatically qualify for the CCP. No other applications are required.

Information for all Cougar Country Promise students

- Those full-time students, in good standing, pursuing a bachelor's degree are eligible for the CCP.
- The CCP does not include the cost of room, board and other applicable fees. Students may also apply a federal student direct loan toward these costs.
- Students not eligible for the MAS program also will be provided an affordable financial aid package from Cleary University.
