



2026–2027 Family Size & Marital Status Verification Worksheet Dependent Student

Your 2026–2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parent(s) reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

- Your parent(s)' other dependent children if your parent(s) do and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Include children who meet these criteria even if they do not live with your parent(s) due to college enrollment.
- Other persons who live with your parent(s) and your parent(s) do and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

** The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" align with the requirement that family size align with whom the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2026-2027 FAFSA. As a result, the student should not include any unborn children in the family size.*
