ACADEMIC MACE



Near the front of the podium is the Cleary University Mace. Our mace, created by the College for Creative Studies in Detroit, was built around a walking stick that originally belonged to P.R. Cleary, founder of the university. The walking stick was a gift to President Cleary from the first graduating class in 1888 and was inscribed as follows, "P R Cleary Class '88." The engraved commemorative text on the top of the walking stick can be read when viewing the mace from the top through a 6-inch focal length optical lens. The mace is comprised of sterling silver and stainless steel. It is approximately 47 inches in length. The mace is made from 12 feet of 5/8-inch stainless bar, forged and fabricated to comprise the linear elements. A 12 x 12-inch sterling silver sheet was hammered and constructed to produce the shoulders, straps, and handle. The head of the mace (insignia seals) are 1/4-inch stainless steel plates etched and cut to specifications. The design and hand construction of the mace required roughly 100 hours of work.

PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION



The concept of the medallion originated in antiquity as a symbol of authority. The medallion was worn for adornment, and its likeness served as the official seal. The Cleary University Presidential Medallion, which is displayed or worn at official ceremonies, symbolizes the authority of the president's office and the president's responsibility for leadership of the institution. This piece was created by the College of Creative Studies in Detroit, and the sterling silver and stainless steel match the materials used in the university's mace. The medallion features the university seal on the front and back and on 16 interlocking plates, of which 10 are presently inscribed with the names and dates of office for the presidents of Cleary University. It measures approximately 32 inches in length and is designed to be displayed flat or worn over the shoulders. The medallion was a gift from Thomas and Barbara Sullivan, who presented it to the university in September 2015.
